The MLS is a diagnostic tool used in the process of identifying SIFE (Students with Interrupted Formal Education). It is used during intake for students who are new to the US. The MLS evaluates students' abilities in reading comprehension and math in their home language. We currently have 18 available languages. Schools in New York State can access the MLS test and register for a free account at mls.slalab.org.
